



**Record:** The data on youth that continue from the youth trade programs to apprenticeship programs.

Data Information:

- From 2016/17 onward, ITA can determine transition rates to apprenticeship from the Train in Trades program and the Youth Explore Trades Skills and Youth Explore Trades Sampler programs.
- In determining the percentage of individuals in the Train in Trades program, the Youth Explore Trades Skills and Youth Explore Trades Sampler programs, who go on to register in an apprenticeship program, the 2016/17 cohort allows enough time for all students to have potentially completed high school.

Data Result:

- In 2016/17 (April 2016 to March 2017), there were 2,112 individuals who registered in a Train in Trades program. Of these individuals, 926 (44%) registered in an apprenticeship program at some point (April 2016 to August 2020) following their registration in the Train in Trades program.
- In 2016/17 (April 2016 to March 2017), there were 1,871 individuals who registered in a Youth Explore Trades Skills and/or Youth Explore Trades Sampler program. Of these individuals, 386 (21%) registered in an apprenticeship program at some point (April 2016 to August 2020) following their registration in the Trades Skills and/or Trades Sampler program.
