Summary of Change:

Please be advised that this is <u>advanced notice</u> of changes to the Apprenticeship Credentialing Model that will be implemented **September 2020**:

- The Auto Collision program will have <u>4 levels</u> of technical training.
- The Auto Collision and Refinishing programs will share a <u>Common Level 1</u>.

Details: As part of the Pan-Canadian review (January-November 2018) of the Red Seal

Occupational Standard (RSOS), the jurisdictions agreed to there being 4 levels of

technical training.

In BC, after extensive consultation with industry and training providers, it is decided that Collision and Refinishing will share a **Common Level 1**. The rationale for this change is to

- a. Provide more flexible career pathways, which may assist in recruiting future technicians
- Allow apprentices to more easily achieve dual certification in these two related trades
- c. Leverage the common competencies between these two trades, especially at Level 1, as outlined in the RSOS

NOTE: The hours assigned to each level will be determined at or after the Program Outline workshops.
