- Boilermaker Certificate of Qualification (CofQ) with Red Seal Endorsement


Occupation Description

Technical Training Completion Requirements

- 2. ITA Standardized Written Exam: achievement minimum 70%
- 3. Work-Based Training Hours: 2,460 (directly related experience working in the Shipbuilding and Repair Industry)
