- Summary of<br/>Change:Please be advised that a technical training duration increase for the Carpenter Program<br/>has been approved by Industry Training Authority (ITA).
- **Rationale:** The need for a technical training duration increase was identified by industry through two Industry Needs Analyses and validated by a Program Review.
- **Details:** Industry consultations undertaken in 2010 and again in 2013 indicated the need for an inschool technical training duration increase. The resulting Industry Needs Analysis flagged that, with the addition of program content to the National Occupational Analysis (NOA) over the years, more in-school time was required to ensure that apprentices had sufficient opportunity to be taught the technical content.

A Carpenter Program Review was conducted in November/December, 2014 to align the ITA Carpenter Program to the 2013 National Occupational Analysis (NOA). The review process validated that the program revisions supported a technical training duration increase.

As a result, ITA approved an increase of the duration of technical training from 6 weeks (180 hours) to 7 weeks (210 hours) across all four levels. **The increase to in-school technical training is effective on or after January 1**<sup>st</sup>, **2016**.
