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Background:	In July 2022, ITA (now SkilledTradesBC) Program Standards issued <u>OPSN-2022-014</u> , which detailed the changes to the RVST Program as a result of the Harmonization Initiative and announced the implementation of a revised Program Outline, effective January 1, 2023. It also detailed changes to the number of work-based training hours.		
	Between July and September 2022, ITA (now SkilledTradesBC) Program Standards consulted with the post-secondary training provider that delivers the RVST program. We evaluated several scenarios, and the transition plan outlined in the graphic below was identified as the best option. We have also ensured that there are options for all current apprentices to complete their apprenticeship.

Other Information:	The CL1 SLEs will be inactivated as of January 1, 2024. The HL1 SLE is in development, and its implementation will be announced by Official Program Standards Notification (OPSN). In the meantime, final marks for HL1 will be based on the in-class marks.
