The Program Outline is aligned to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition of the 2012 Canadian Electrical Code.  
Delivery of training for the Construction Electrician apprenticeship program is to be based on the updated program outline as of January 1, 2015.

**Background**

The Construction Industry Training Organization (CITO) completed a review of the Construction Electrician (CE) apprenticeship program in 2012 in consultation with industry and training providers to ensure trade currency and alignment with the 2011 National Occupational Analysis (NOA).

The CITO review of the Program Outline content resulted in very little change to program content since the previous NOA. The Program Outline represents the most current technologies and practices for the Construction Electrician trade.

A second review of the program in 2013 was undertaken by CITO at the request of the Construction Electrician Articulation Committee. This review resulted in no change to program content but did result in some re-arrangement of content. This re-arrangement reflects alignment to the order of delivery of the competencies for the in-school technical training.
