Mr. Baker graduated from the University of Victoria in 1989 with a Bachelor's degree in Political Science and has spent a majority of his professional career focusing on training and development, project planning and project management. Mr. Baker consulted for a number of organizations, offering management services in the areas of start up and funding, business plan development, employment and training, and processes and efficiencies. He has also consulted on a variety of hospitality, cultural and special events organizations, such as Klahowya Village in Stanley Park (Indigenous Tourism Association of BC) and 2010 Aboriginal Pavilion (Four Host First Nations - Winter Olympic).
