Working with the Squamish Nation Training & Trade Centre as a Development & Partnership Employment Negotiator, Peter Baker's focus is to organize job practicums and identify potential employment opportunities for graduating students. The goal is to develop realistic processes for researching and negotiating student practicum placements relating to fulltime, meaningful employment opportunities with trade industry or sponsorship into labor organizations. Mr. Baker also works closely with education partners to develop valued introduction trades courses that meet industry demand and is an instructor on a part time basis.

Mr. Baker graduated from the University of Victoria in 1989 with a Bachelor's degree in Political Science and has spent a majority of his professional career focusing on training and development, project planning and project management. Mr. Baker consulted for a number of organizations, offering management services in the areas of start up and funding, business plan development, employment and training, and processes and efficiencies.
