Information: Please be advised that an updated Program Outline for the Baker program is now posted on the ITA website at www.itabc.ca.

Background go2hr, the Industry Training Organization for the Hospitality and Tourism industry sector, completed a review of the Baker apprenticeship program in consultation with industry and training providers to ensure trade currency and alignment with the new 2011 National Occupational Analysis (NOA).

The program review resulted in minor changes to the Program Outline. The Standardized Level Exams (SLEs) for this program have been reviewed and modified to align with the changes. The new SLEs will be introduced to coincide with program delivery.

Development of a new Interprovincial Red Seal examination that aligns with the new NOA is currently underway. Notification announcing implementation of the new Red Seal exam will be distributed once the exam becomes available.

Delivery of training for Levels 1 and 2 of the Baker apprenticeship program is to be based on the updated Program Outline as of September 1, 2014.

For those apprentices who will be in Level 3 of the Baker apprenticeship program in September 2014, the current Program Outline should apply. The delivery of the new Level 3 content will not be implemented until the winter term of 2015-16. The current Program Outline will remain on the ITA website until these students complete.
