Credential Issued:

ITA Certificate of Qualification (Agricultural Equipment Technician)
Inter-Provincial Red Seal Endorsement (Agricultural Equipment Technician)
(Persons completing a formal apprenticeship also receive a Certificate of Apprenticeship)

Occupational Description:

“Agricultural Equipment Technician” means a person who repairs power driven farm equipment and any of the associated attachments, or specialty equipment that may be deemed to be of an agricultural nature.

Program Duration & Structure:

8,790 documented hours of directly related work experience required to challenge Inter-Provincial Red Seal examination.

- In-school assessments (practical and written exams)
- Work-based assessments (practical)
- Final Assessment (Inter-Provincial Red Seal written examination)

- Holders of a BC Certificate of Qualification in Automotive Service Technician, Commercial Transport Mechanic, Diesel Engine Mechanic and Heavy Duty Mechanic may be eligible to receive practical experience credit and technical training credit.
