Occupation Description

“Oil Heat System Technician” means a person who installs repairs and maintains all types of oil fired domestic and commercial equipment or components.

Pathways to Certification

In BC, an individual can become certified as an Oil Heat System Technician program by challenging the certification. Challenge programs are for individuals who have extensive experience working in the occupation and wish to challenge the certification. No apprenticeship program is currently available in BC for this trade.

ITA Registration

Those who wish to challenge the Oil Heat System Technician certification must complete the Oil Heat System Technician Challenge Application and submit it to ITA. Challenge applications are assessed for proof of workplace hours and scope of experience prior to acceptance of the individual into the Challenge pathway.



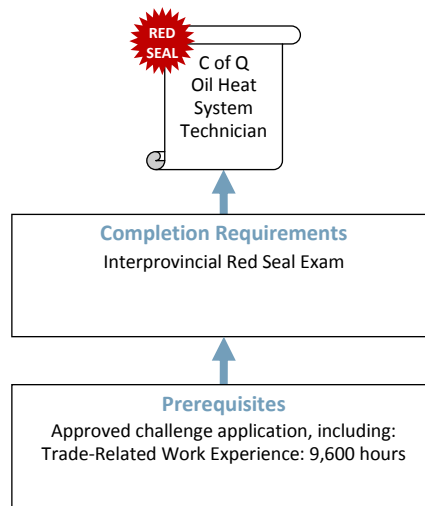
Apprenticeship Pathway
